

[redacted] Met with John Martin, Chief Counsel, House Ways and Means Committee, and discussed with him the background of various pieces of legislation involving tax exemption for disability payments. In brief Martin advised that even though there has been no change in the overall attitude of the Committee opposing such measures, anticipated changes in the composition of the Committee after January could provide a more favorable climate for consideration of an amendment to the Agency Retirement Act.
