25X1 3. [redacted] General Ray Furlong, Deputy Assistant  
Secretary of Defense for Legislative Affairs, called in response to Maury's  
call yesterday and said that Jack Marsh would look into the matter of [redacted]

25X1 4. [redacted] Called Stu French, ISA, to tell him I had  
talked with our people about the possibility of an overseas assignment of a  
particular individual about whom French had earlier inquired. I said our  
people were working on this and it was possible that we would regard it as  
25X1 a desirable assignment but I could give him no assurances at this time.  
[redacted] WH Division, will be in touch with me further about this.

25X1 5. [redacted] Talked with Scott Cohen, Executive Assistant  
to Senator Charles H. Percy (R., Ill.), about the Senator's inquiry on the role  
of the Soviets in the Middle East oil situation. We discussed the possibility  
of getting together with the Senator for a briefing and Cohen suggested that,  
if possible, we provide the Senator with a briefing paper in view of his very  
tight schedule between now and Christmas. I told Cohen I thought we had  
25X1 such a paper and we would arrange to get it to him. I passed this on to [redacted]  
[redacted] ODDI, who will get the paper to us. 25X1

25X1 6. [redacted] Met with Miss Marsha Matt, House Appro-  
priations Committee and received from her copies of the Committee report  
and letter to Secretary of Defense concerning shipments of foreign made/  
25X1 foreign purchased private-owner vehicles at government expense. [redacted] 25X1  
[redacted] DDM&S, has been advised.

25X1 7. [redacted] Met with Chairman Lucien Nedzi  
(D., Mich.) and briefed him on recent information concerning metro-  
politan police departments and Agency utilization of newspapermen.  
Chairman Nedzi said he would appreciate additional detailed information  
25X1 on the number of persons involved and financial arrangements concerning  
the newsmen. He had no subsequent questions on the MPD item. [redacted]  
[redacted] OS and Angus Thuermer have been advised.
