25X1 1. [redacted] (GLC) [redacted] called regarding a query he got from the Operations Center last night concerning the provision of certain of our publications to the Vice President designate. After checking with Mr. Lehman, C/OCI, I found that any publications we are providing Representative Ford are being handled through the White House situation room. 25X1

25X1 2. [redacted] (GLC) Met with John Goldsmith, Senate Armed Services Committee staff, at his request to go over the situation in [redacted] Goldsmith is interested in any feeling that we might have developed about the new Cabinet appointees and the role of the military in the future. I told him I would check on these and several other things he asked about and be back in touch with him. 25X1

25X1 3. [redacted] (GLC) In a conversation with Al Tarabochia, Senate Internal Security Subcommittee staff, he mentioned he had talked with [redacted] [redacted] about the material he was forwarding for [redacted] [redacted] was making arrangements [redacted] to call Tarabochia as Tarabochia requested. I again tried to 25X1 politely discourage Tarabochia from getting too involved with [redacted] 25X1 indicating that it had been necessary for us to break our rehabilitation pattern to satisfy his request for a meeting with [redacted] and Tarabochia might find 25X1 that he had [redacted] around his neck if he gave him much encouragement. 25X1 Tarabochia claimed to appreciate this situation and said he had noted some of the factors that I said might appear.

25X1 5. [redacted] (KKH) Received a call from [redacted] 25X1 in the office of Representative Robert H. Steele(R., Conn.), requesting a 25X1 personnel interview for herself. [redacted] OP, was contacted and an appointment was set up for 10 a.m., Tuesday, 23 October. [redacted] was notified.

25X1 6. [redacted] Called Marshall Wright, Assistant Secretary of State for Congressional Relations, this morning and told him of the conversation that [redacted] OCI, and I had with Senator Bennett Johnston (D., La.) and two members of his staff over the phone last night. I told him that in view of Johnston's statements that State had not seen any cause for concern regarding his trip we had backed off somewhat in advising him against going, although [redacted] pointed out the risks of a visit to Israel. 25X1 Wright said he had also backed off after he had talked [redacted] and found that [redacted] had seen no problems in the Senator's going to the Middle East. 25X1

25X1 7. [redacted] Left with the staff of Representative James Jones (D., Okla.) an unclassified map of the Middle East area which he might find useful. I requested only that the Congressman not indicate the Agency as the source of the map since we had only a limited supply of them. 25X1

8. [redacted] Late in the day Mr. Lehman's office, in the White House, called to invite Mr. Maury to attend a meeting in Mr. Timmon's office in the White House tomorrow at 9:30 a.m. to discuss the Middle East situation. I confirmed that Mr. Maury would attend. 25X1

9. [redacted] Met with Dr. John Brady, House Foreign Affairs Committee staff, and received from him a draft Committee sketch labeled "The Drug Traffic" (figure 2) for our review. [redacted] NARCOG, has been advised. 25X1

10. [redacted] Talked to Garner J. Cline, Counsel, Subcommittee on Immigration, Citizenship and International Law, House Judiciary Committee, several times during the day concerning the briefing on terrorism scheduled for Thursday, 18 October. Due to the press of Committee business, it was finally necessary to cancel the briefing for the present. Bill Nelson, DDO, and [redacted] CI Staff, have been advised. 25X1

11. [redacted] Received a call from Dorothy Fosdick, Senate Permanent Investigations Subcommittee staff, who asked that I come by in the morning to talk to her about a matter that cannot be discussed on the telephone. 25X1
