Purpose: To direct the Secretary of Commerce to conduct a comprehensive study of the allocations of frequencies for telecommunications

Comment:

This bill has been introduced for several Congresses and has never become active.

Position:

Chairman Stagers, of the House Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce, by letter dated February 28 to the Director, requested CIA comments on H. R. 3251. The Agency has consistently taken a no objection position to the bill. A similar reply was coordinated with DDM&S and Commo and sent to OMB for clearance on 22 March. On the same date, [REDACTED] sent an interim to Chairman Stagers.
