Agreed Activities and upon being advised by Messrs. Wisner and ______ that they were not satisfied with the language of the latest paper draws on this subject directed that:

(1) ______ redraft and circulate to his opposites in the Service Intelligence Agencies a paper which will include the changes desired by DD/P and COP; (2) if this paper is not acceptable, a meeting of the principals should be called at which time consideration will be given to our proposal and that of the other Intelligence Agencies concerned. The Birector made it clear he did not wish to circulate a paper on this subject in which there was the slightest objection on the part of CIA and agreed with General Cabell that we should not lose our momentum on this problem.
