1. Approved of Dr. Tietjen going on leave during the last two weeks in July.

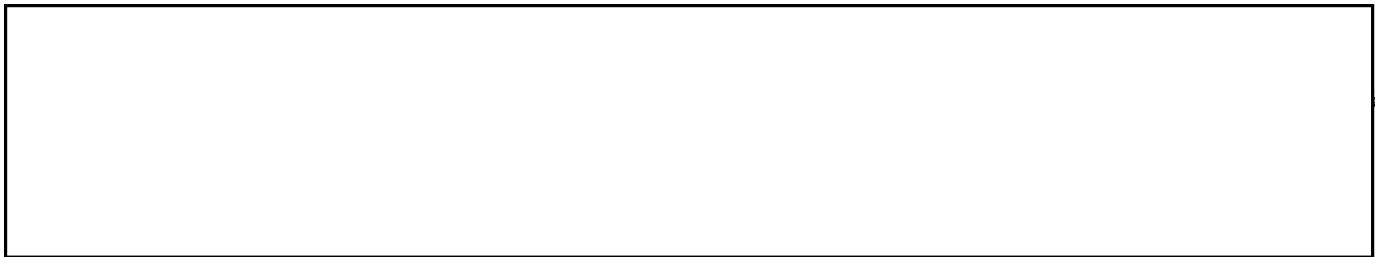
