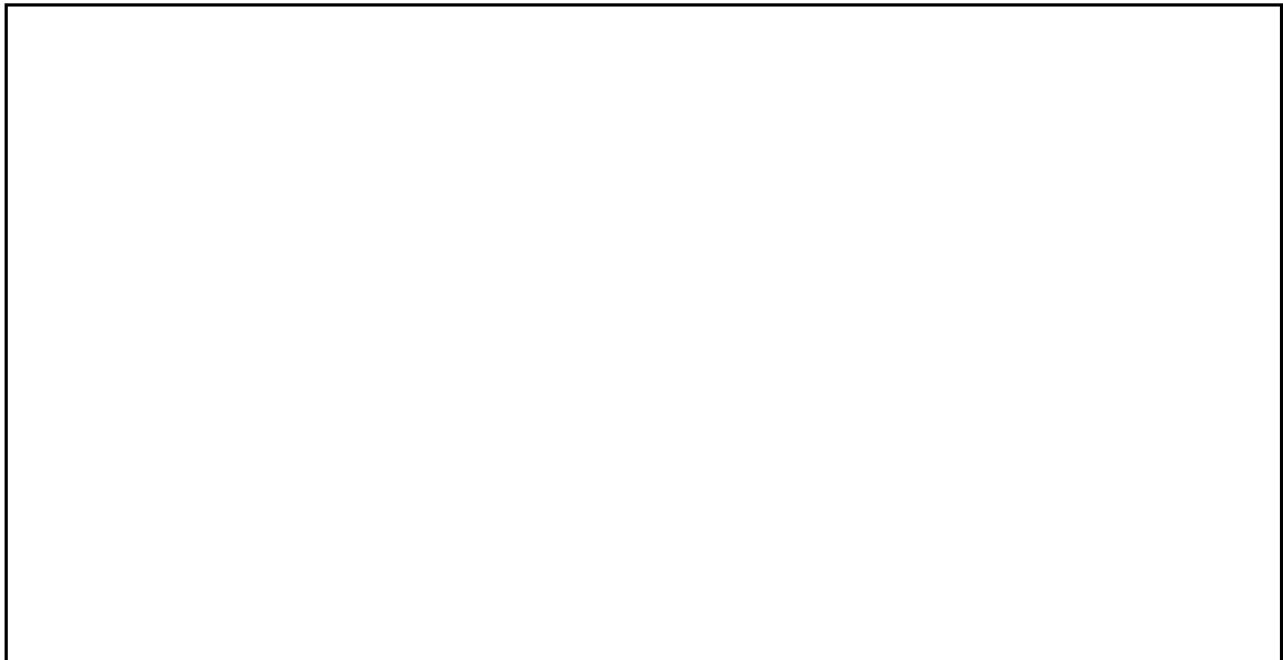

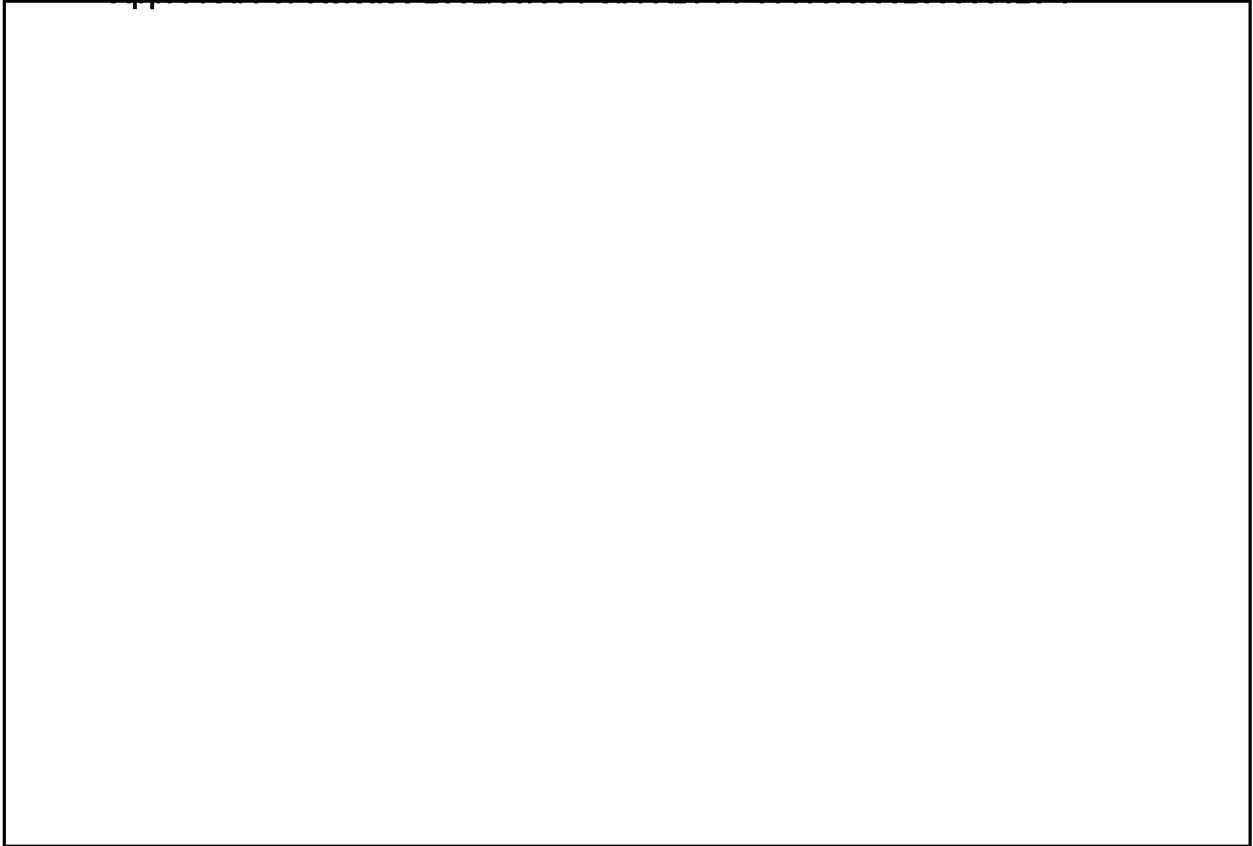

Mr. Dulles:

25X1A9A a) Referred to an editorial in the Washington Post  
25X1A9A by the Alsop brothers concerning George Kennan's views as  
expressed in a private interview between the Alsops and  
Kennan. He noted that Kennan's present views appear to  
differ in tone considerably from the line he has been taking  
in the past. Mr. Wisner agreed and suggested that either  
[redacted] or [redacted] arrange to see Kennan and have a  
discussion with him. Mr. Wisner undertook to see that this  
is followed up. ACTION: COP.

b) Stated that he believed we should review the  
status of the estimates on the satellites and asked to have  
copies of these estimates sent to him. Mr. Amory agreed  
and stated that the DD/I is preparing to review also its  
estimate of the world situation. ACTION: DD/I.
