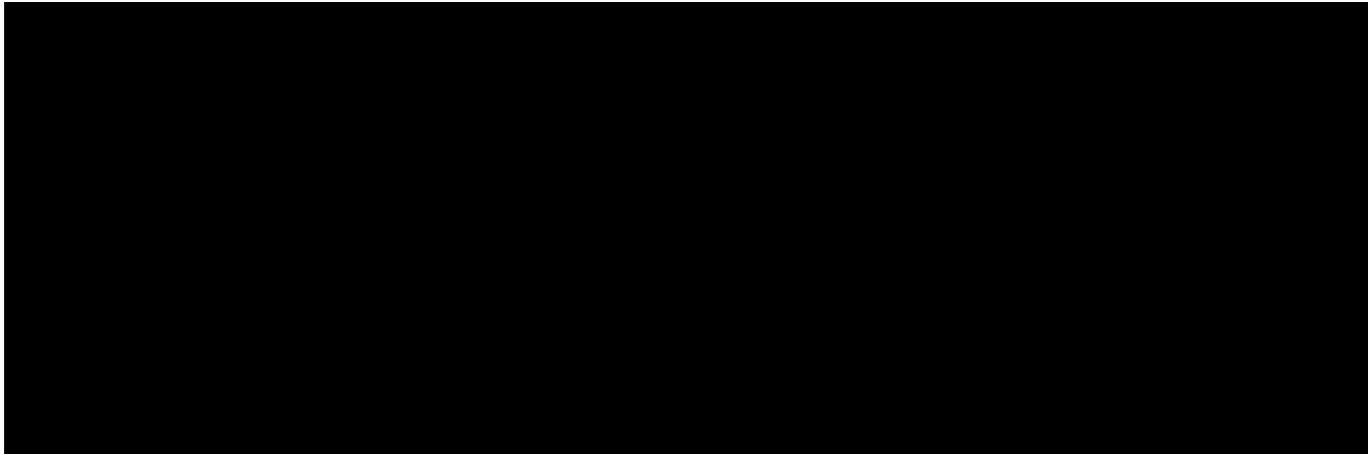
11. Colonel Grogan advised me that the General Services Administration was about to announce the award of our grading contract to the North American Construction Company in the amount of \$458,000.
