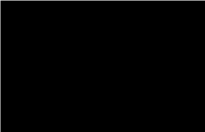

He hoped that I would do the first article as a general introduction to the series and that it could be ready by 15 February. I told him that I would certainly consider this matter and discuss it with my Office Heads at an early date. I made no commitments, however, and said that I was very pessimistic that I could turn out anything before the 15th of February. I also commented that Support had been such a controversial subject in the Agency that I would want to make sure that anything I put out over my own signature had the tacit approval of other senior officials.
