We agreed to give Dr. Tietjen a few more weeks to come up with his recommendation regarding Mr. [redacted]. (On 14 June Shef, Bill, and I talked with Ting on the [redacted] and Ting agreed that he should be asked to resign and that if he refuses, he should be terminated by the Director under his special authority. I talked with Richard Helms on the phone about Mr. [redacted]. He will pull together information pertinent to [redacted] case and then give me a ring, at which time we will get together and decide what our recommendation should be.)
