1. During my medical briefing by John Tietjen he reported the following:

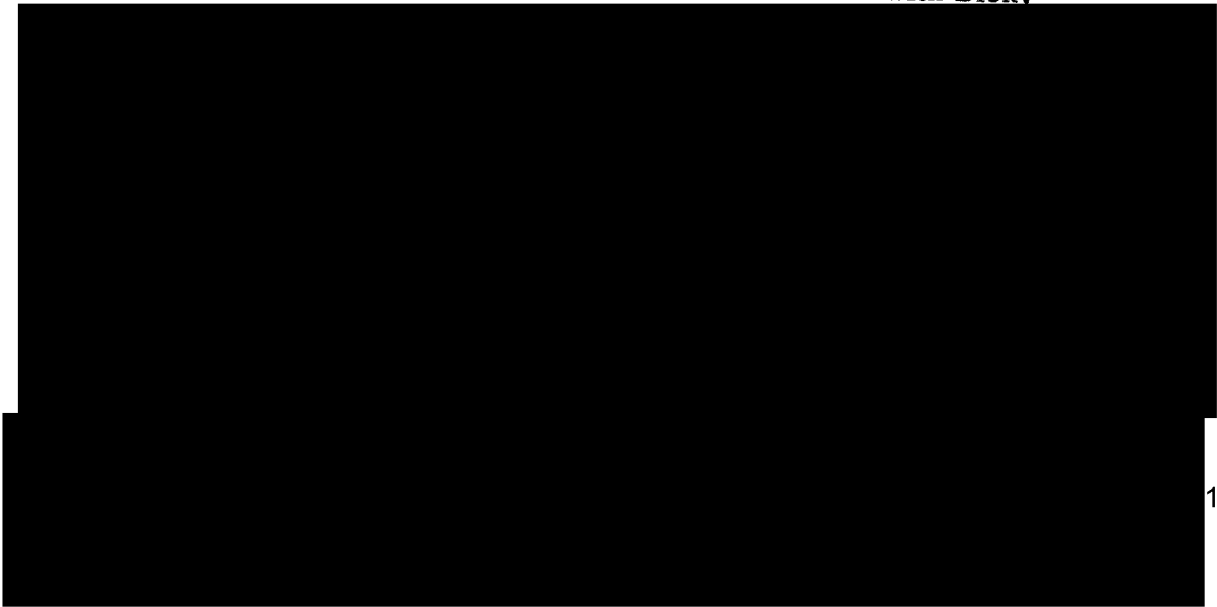
