1. [REDACTED] raised the question with me of whether we have the green light to construct our printing plant without first touching base with our Senate committees. I told him that Mr. Kirkpatrick had assured me that we did have the green light but said that I would double check. I talked with Kirk about this. He thought that it was not necessary to obtain Senator Russell's approval but that it might be courteous to tell him about it. I asked him to assume the responsibility for doing this inasmuch as the Director is now scheduled to see Senator Russell at noon on Tuesday, 4 August.

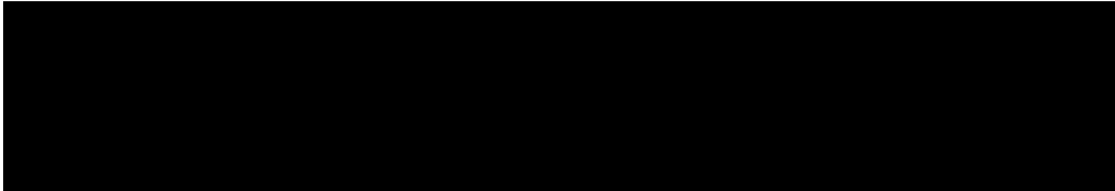

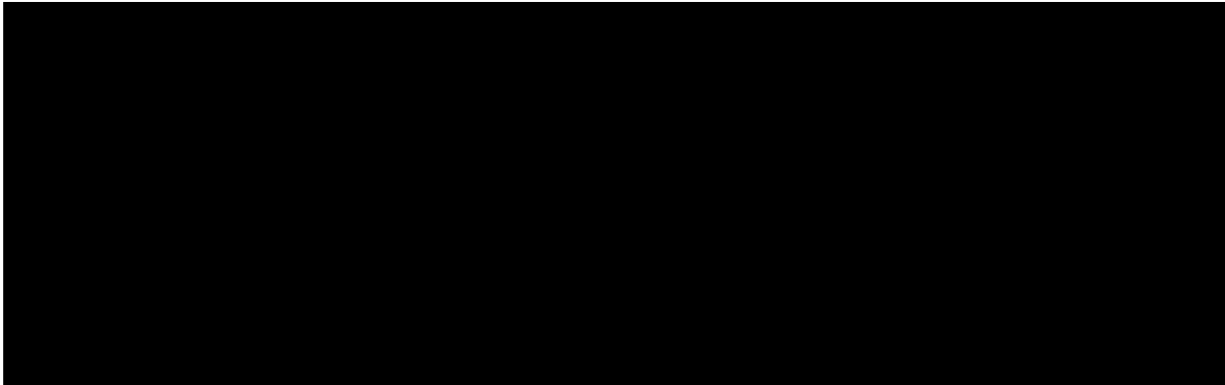

6. At the Executive Committee Meeting this morning:



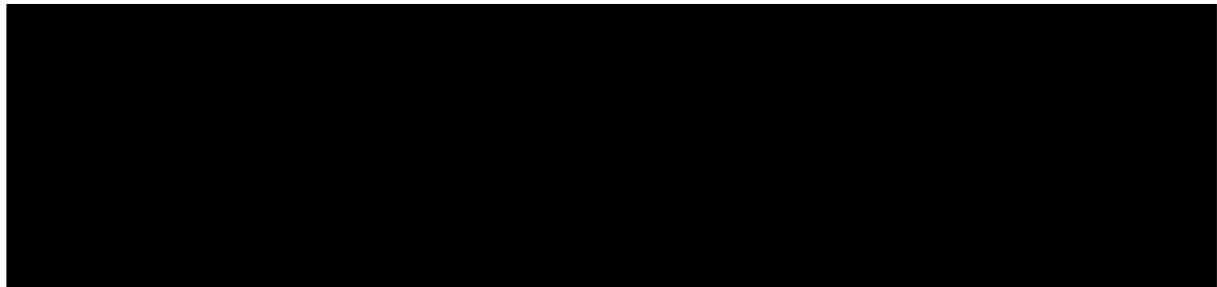
