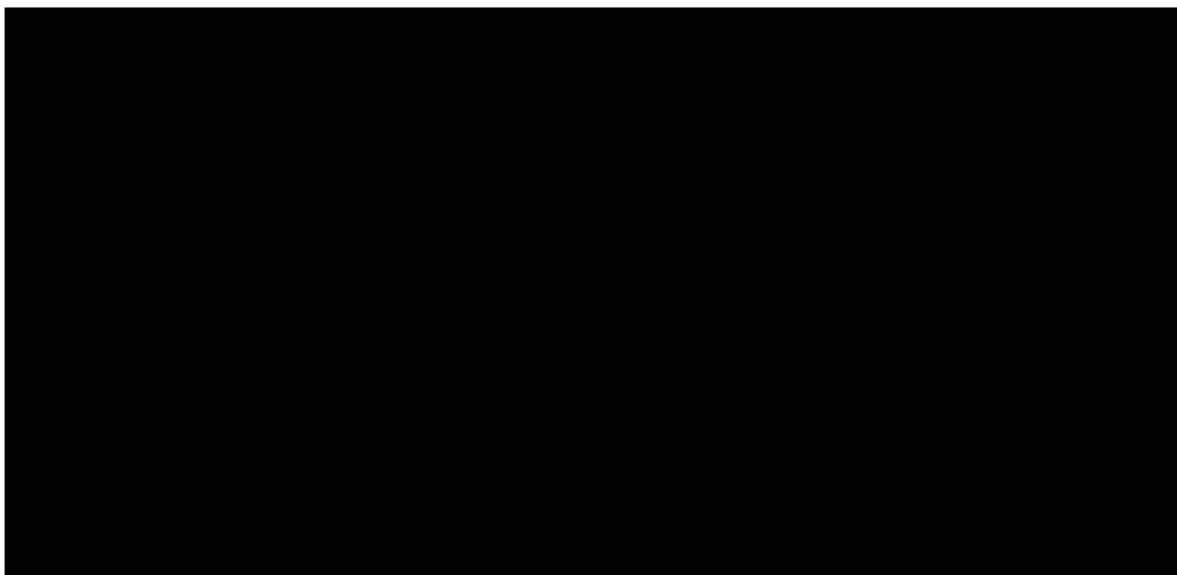

General Kuter telephoned me in General Carter's absence to say that, when he had lunch with General Carter on 31 July, he had expressed some apprehension about jeopardizing Pan American Airways operations in Kenya by flying from Rio de Janeiro to Johannesburg. Since the luncheon he had talked to Juan Tripp, President of PAA, who has no such apprehensions. General Kuter asked that this information be put in the proper channels.
