[Redacted] gave him a copy of our recruitment brochure and also a copy of Mr. Dulles' book, The Craft of Intelligence. Mr. Castwit's book is now in final draft, and he sent the section of it which deals with the Intelligence Community and CIA to [Redacted] for his personal comments. (I referred this matter to Paul Chretien and requested that he confer with Emmett and decide what we should do. Offhand, it seems to me that we should draft a letter to Castwit for [Redacted] signature saying that he has no authority to comment on this book and that, if Castwit wishes to submit it for clearance or inaccuracies, he should send it to CIA Headquarters in Washington, D. C.)

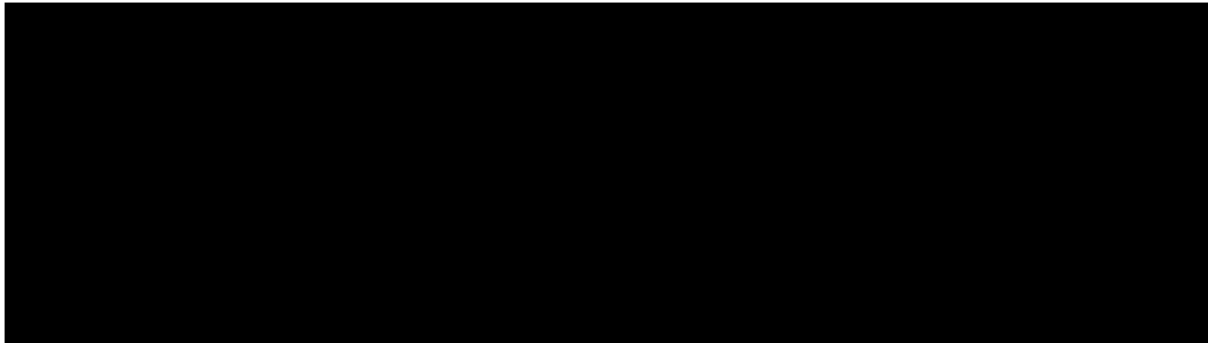
