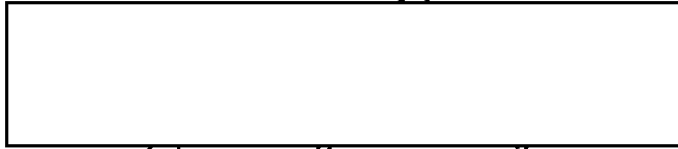

Attached for your signature is a reply to a letter from Senator Tunney, as Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Subcommittee on Constitutional Rights, inquiring as to whether the Agency maintains files on American citizens in secret repositories for use during emergency situations.

The Agency in the past did include American citizens in such lists that were maintained as part of the emergency relocation program. The lists were not properly updated as the emergency program lost its importance and they were destroyed a number of years ago. There is no present requirement to maintain such lists as part of the Agency's existing emergency relocation program.
