14. (Secret - PLC) Delivered to J. Sourwine, Chief Counsel, Senate Judiciary Subcommittee on Internal Security, a brief summary on [redacted] prepared by CI Staff. Sourwine said this would satisfy his request unless we heard anything further.

15. (Confidential - PLC) Sat in on a briefing for Skip Spenceley, House Merchant Marine and Fisheries Subcommittee on Fisheries and Wildlife Conservation and the Environment staff, given by [redacted] OER. The briefing concerned the effect on the Japanese economy if all their fish imports into the United States are cut off.

16. (Unclassified - PLC) Called Ralph Malvick, OMB, to confirm with him that we were working on the inflationary impact statement on the Agency's retirement package but that his questions on this prompted the Agency to request an exemption from the provisions of OMB Circular A-107 since any legislation prepared by the Agency would have no direct impact on the domestic economy. Malvick said he would be expecting our letter shortly.
