25X1	Government Operations Subcommittee on Government Information and Individual Rights, called to alert us that Chairman Bella S. Abzug (D., N. Y.) will request the Director to appear next Thursday, 27 February, before the Subcommittee. The subject will be the Agency's exemption in the Privacy Act of 1974. Chairman Abzug has introduced legislation (H.R. 2635) to strike the exemption. The hearing will be investigatory and open, and the Director will be placed under oath. I discussed with Kronfeld the basic position of the Agency to seek an exemption for intelligence sources and methods if the exemption for all CIA files is struck. Kronfeld thought this approach would be best. He offered to work out with me any suitable 25X1 language to amend the Act along these lines.
