[Redacted] LIAISON CONGRESSIONAL TRAVEL Talked with Clark McFadden, Counsel, Senate Armed Services Committee, to finalize arrangements for his contact with our Station Chiefs in [Redacted] [Redacted] After coordination, a cable authorizing such contact with McFadden was sent. McFadden was given the names of our Station Chiefs in [Redacted] [Redacted] McFadden asked for information which was promised him earlier by this office concerning the DCI's testimony to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence Operations, Chairman Frank Church (D., Idaho), [Redacted] [Redacted] McFadden was doing a paper for Senator Robert Taft, Jr. (R., Ohio) on this subject and needed this material. I told McFadden that I had a memo on Vang Pao for him but he asked that I hold it until he got back from his trip. He also mentioned that he was doing a statement for Senator John Stennis (D., Miss.) on congressional oversight of CIA for use before the Senate Government Operations Committee in mid-January.
