SUBJECT: Paper Entitled "Operational Plan of International Communism in Latin America"

TO: All ARA Diplomatic Posts

Transmitted herewith are five copies of a Spanish translation of an unclassified paper entitled "Operational Plan of International Communism in Latin America." Rio de Janeiro and Port-au-Prince may wish to have it translated into Portuguese and French respectively.

This document was prepared with the intention that it should be made available to Latin American governments as part of the exchange of information on the activities of international communism envisaged in Resolution 93 adopted by the Tenth Inter-American Conference at Caracas in March 1954. It is considered that it should now be utilized for this purpose in connection with the designation of liaison officers to handle such exchanges as requested in CA-6007, February 8, 1956. At an appropriate time after the local government and Embassy have designated their respective liaison officers and when they have established contact and discussed the purpose of their designation, one copy of this document should be transmitted to the designated local official. It is suggested that it be delivered in three installments: pages 1 - 11 might be delivered first; pages 12 - 26 at some later convenient date; and the balance still later. The Embassy liaison officer should encourage his counterpart to discuss the paper and related matters, particularly as they may relate to the country of assignment, and should, of course, report the results to the Department. The delivery of the document should also be reported.

A second copy of the document should be reserved for use in briefing local officials and selected private citizens contemplating visits to the Soviet bloc, which will be the subject of a subsequent instruction from the Department.

A copy of the document may prove useful to the Mission in carrying out the instructions contained in the Department's circular telegram no. 533, of February 8 (sent to Rio de Janeiro as no. 932) with regard to speeches by Latin Americans against the current Soviet campaign in the area. At the discretion of the Mission, this document could be shown confidentially to selected persons who might be
