Reference is made to your letter dated April 12, 1960, your reference [redacted] enclosing five copies of your brief captioned as above.

The brief has been reviewed with considerable interest as this Bureau is most concerned over the spread of communism in Latin America and the recent increase of Soviet-type activities in that area. The educational program for the Party cadres now being utilized by the Communist Parties throughout Latin America, as set forth in the brief, indicate that the United States can well expect an increase both in quantity and quality of communist propaganda in Latin America aimed at this country.

This Bureau does not have additional information regarding Communist Party schools now being conducted in Latin America. We would appreciate receiving any additional data developed by your Agency on the communist situation in Latin America.
