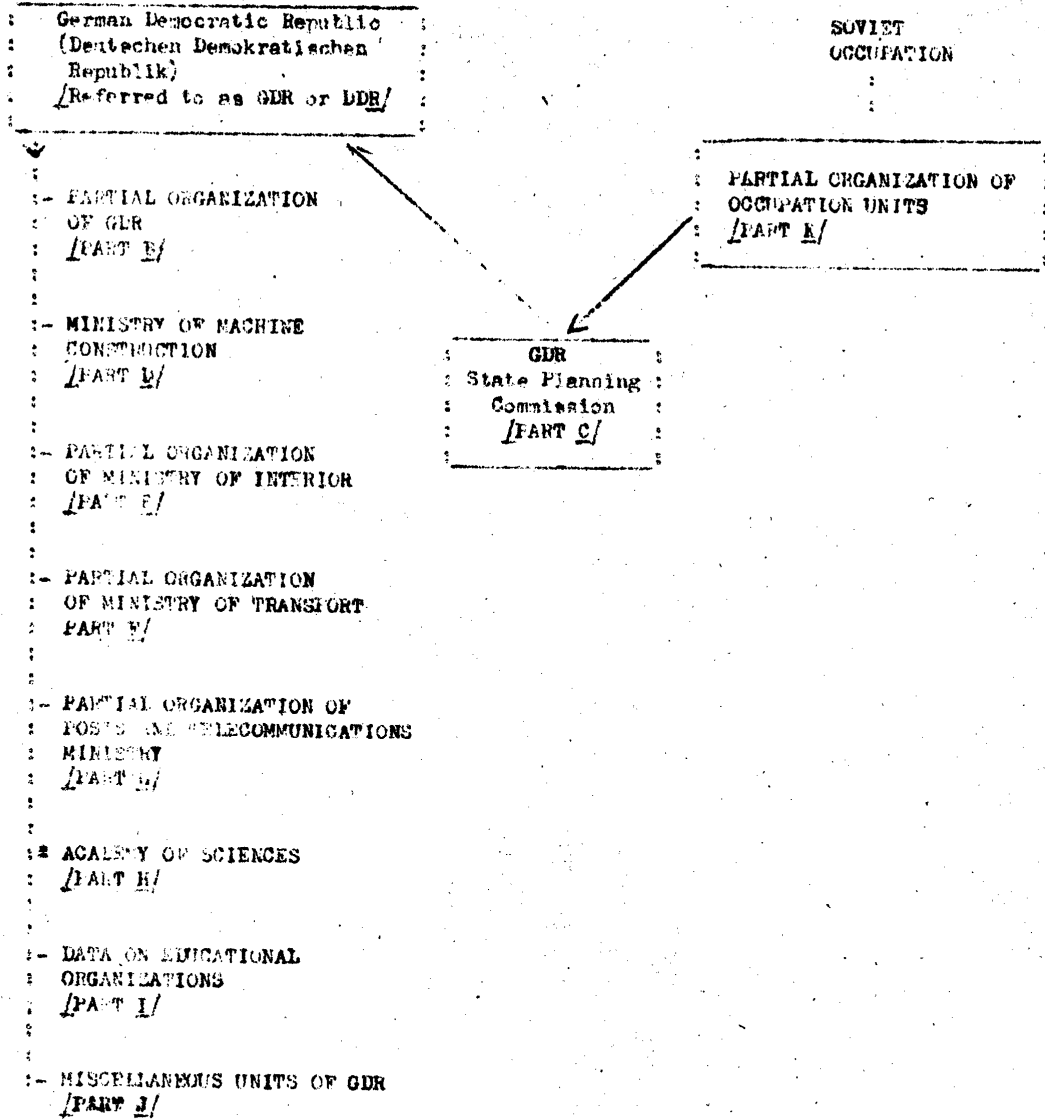

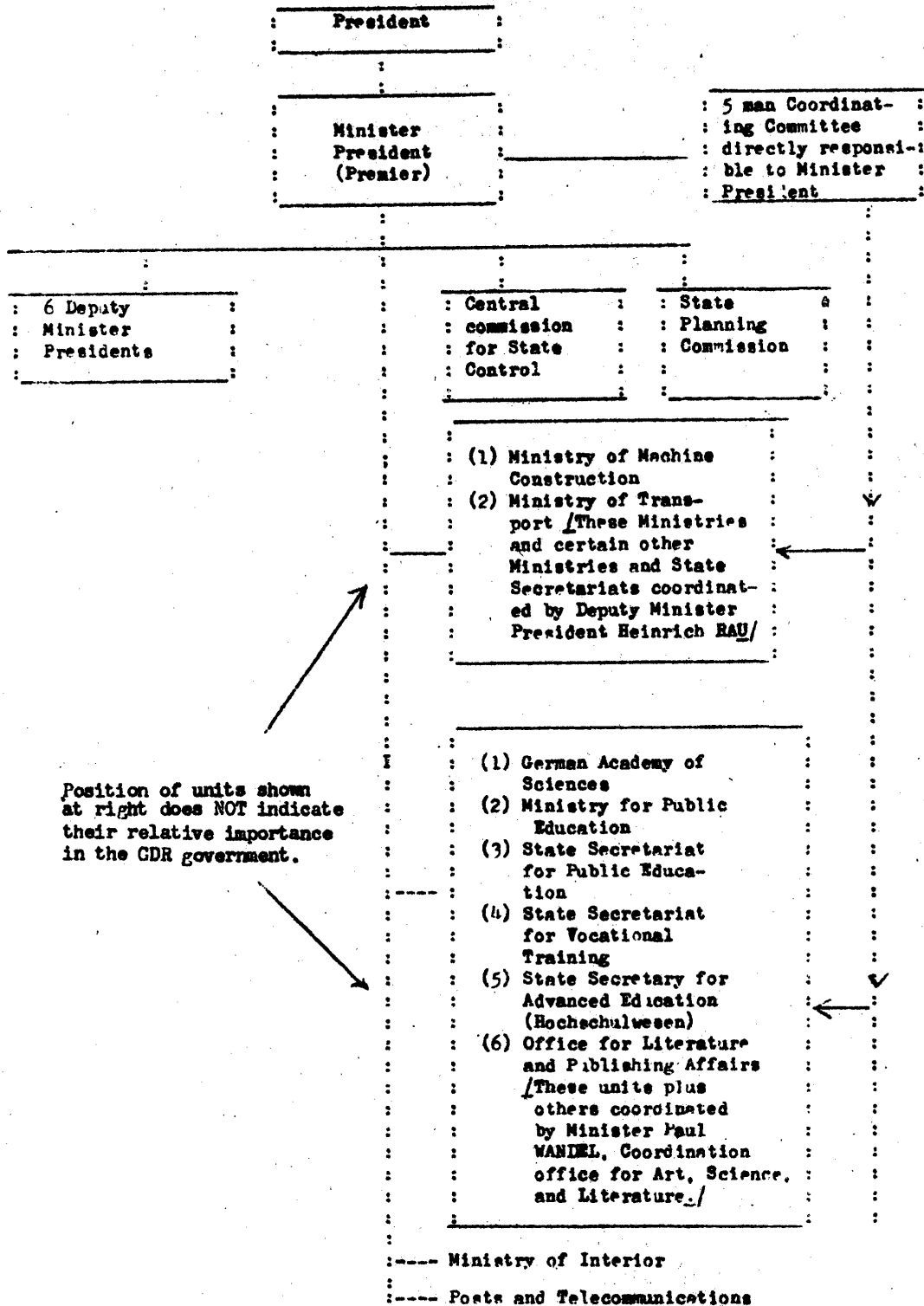

1 The Ministry of Machine Construction contains two Main Departments which direct the activities of the majority of those units in the GDR which are concerned with electronics, electrotechnology, optics, (including geodetic instruments), and precision mechanics.

Part D includes a detailed list of laboratories and factories in these fields.

Note: According to the German radio of 21 December 52: "As one Ministry can no longer cope with the systematic development and supervision of the mechanical engineering industry in creating the bases of Socialism, the Council of Ministers decided to dissolve the Ministry for Machine Construction. It will be replaced by the Ministry for Heavy Mechanical Engineering (Ministerium fuer Schwermaschinenbau), the Ministry for Construction of Transport and Agricultural Machinery (Ministerium fuer Transportmitteln und Landmaschinenbau), Ministry for General Engineering (Ministerium fuer Allgemeinen Maschinenbau)."

If this unconfirmed report is true, the Ministry will be split along the general lines of the Main Administrations (Hauptverwaltung) shown in this Part of the study.

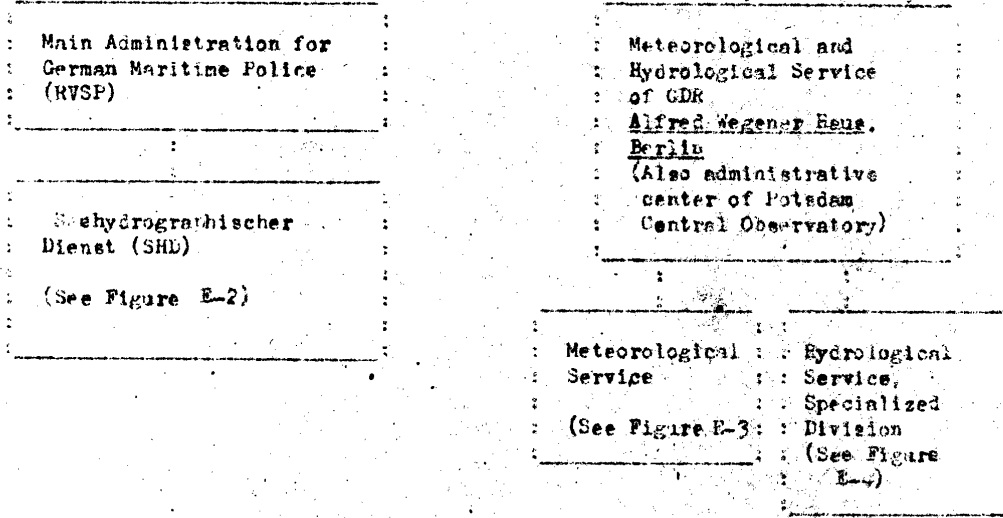

Note: On 31 Jan 52 a Main Division for Vocational Training was established under the State Secretariat for Advanced Education (See Figure I-2). The latest intelligence indicates that the State Secretariat for Vocational Training is still in being. Division of responsibility between the two organizations is not clear.

- :-- Guidance and supervision of the responsible ministries in the selection and assignment of teaching staffs for the vocational schools. The Main Division for Vocational Training will select and approve the instructors.

Note: The competent ministries of the German Democratic Republic will bear the responsibility for the vocational schools, whose branches of specialization will be adapted to the scope of responsibilities of the ministries. The competent ministries are to assume the following responsibilities in connection with the vocational schools:

- a. Administration of the vocational schools with regard to curriculum, finances, and personnel; guidance and supervision of these schools, in accordance with directives issued by the Main Division for Vocational Training.
- b. Development of plans for curricula and training aids, on the basis of scientific progress and up-to-date practical experience; presentation of such plans to the Main Division for Vocational Training, for approval.
- c. The selection of vocational students, guidance and placement of graduates, and appointment of instructors for the vocational schools, in accordance with directives issued by the Main Division for Vocational Training.

Existing vocational schools which specialize in engineering are to be separated from the vocational school system and placed under the jurisdiction of the competent ministries of the German Democratic Republic.

When the Verein Deutscher Ingenieure (Association of German Engineers) and the Verein Deutscher Elektrotechniker (Association of German Electrical Engineers) were dissolved during 1945 and 1946 by the Allied Komendatura in Berlin, the Free German Trade Union Associations founded the Chamber of Technology. It was hoped that the Chamber could be developed into a four-personal mass organization which eventually would include all German scientists and technicians.

Approval of the statutes of the Chamber which were submitted to the Allied Komendatura was delayed, however, and in order to force a decision, the Soviets licensed the Chamber on 8 May 1946 for the Soviet Occupation Zone.

The position occupied by the Chamber of Technology within the organization of the GDR is not clear. One report places it under the minister of the Interior. Another states the Chamber was placed under the Ministry of Public Education by a governmental decree of 31 March 1949. It is probable that both reports are in error and that the Chamber of Technology is a semi-private organization not directly under State control.
