RUMANIA: Food situation acute -- Gheorghiu Dej, new Communist Minister of National Economy, has indicated to US Representative Berry that the Government is "extremely disturbed" over prospects of widespread famine this winter. He said that, unless adequate help arrives, starvation will be general after January. Dej hinted that the Opposition was stirring up trouble and that he "was by no means certain" of the Government's ability to maintain order in view of "anticipated growing unrest."

IRAN: Reported intention of Iran to garrison Soviet frontier -- US Military Attache Tehran reports that the Central Government is continuing to consolidate its military occupation of Azerbaijan and intends to establish strong garrisons in towns along the Soviet frontier. The MA also reports Qavam's announcement that elections will now proceed and that the Soviet Oil concession will be granted after Parliament convenes.
