MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Training

SUBJECT : Training Films

1. Attached are some comments, somewhat informal and already given to you in part orally, on certain films in use in the Office of Training. With regard to the four-part film on the DDI and the intelligence process and the film "Resume," I have given my views and recommendations orally to the head of your Intelligence School and to the head of the Orientation and Briefing faculty. I am not, however, giving this memorandum any distribution within OTR except to you.

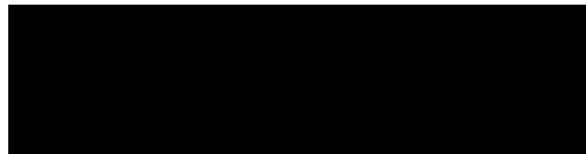
2. I recommend that:

a. Use of the four-part film on the DDI and the intelligence process be discontinued, since the film is very much out of date on organizational structure and, more important, gives a misleading picture of how the DDI operates and intelligence is produced;

b. use of the film "Resume" be discontinued, largely for the reasons given in a. above but also because I question the value in today's world of the clippings from old operational training films; and

c. the film "The Academy Anonymous" not be used, as I understand was intended, for high-level non-Agency audiences unless the present sound-track commentary be changed to delete what seem to me unrealistic statements.
