ADVANCED INTELLIGENCE SEMINARS

The complete schedule for the Advanced Intelligence Seminars to be offered during FY 71 is announced to assist components and individual applicants in planning their participation. Scheduled dates for the FY 71 cycle are:

AIS 1-71: 12-23 October 1970
AIS 2-71: 8-19 March 1971
AIS 3-71: 10-21 May 1971

The Advanced Intelligence Seminar is a middle and senior level course designed for experienced personnel from all parts of the Agency. It places major emphasis upon (1) dynamic aspects of the changing international and domestic scenes influencing U.S. intelligence; (2) current and projected developments within the Agency and the Intelligence Community generally; and (3) an examination of the intelligence approach to selected substantive problems.

To the maximum degree possible, the course is conducted in the atmosphere of a seminar to provide opportunities for members to engage in dialogue with the speakers (particularly Senior officials of the Agency) and to appreciate the viewpoints and problems of colleagues from other Directorates.
