The Chairman called attention to the fact that the Office of General Counsel was examining the wording contained in Public Law 88-643, Part J, Cost-of-Living Adjustments of Annuities, in order to determine if it would permit the granting of cost-of-living increases to annuitants under the CIA Retirement System, including provision for retroactive coverage, in line with any future changes as may be approved for annuitants under the Civil Service Retirement System. It was generally agreed that annuitants or prospective annuitants under the CIA Retirement System should be appropriately informed should such study reveal that they are not entitled to cost-of-living increases under the same conditions as annuitants under the Civil Service Retirement System.
