Dear Sir:

This will confirm a phone conversation between yourself and a representative of my Office advising that the AS-3 equipment customer desires that the transmitter and keyer remain separate components in order to retain minimum individual component size. The miniaturised hand key is also preferred to the "button" called for in the Specifications. Because independent use of the transmitter is visualized, both the hand key and T/R switch should be mounted on the transmitter component.

Enclosed are photographs of the RS-11 radio set, the RR-11AA receiver and an equipment handbook for the ATP-2 facsimile printer, which you may find helpful.
