Before this information could be obtained, a hold was placed on the project and work on this task was stopped.

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3. This contract terminated on 27 June 1959 with approximately \$50,000 remaining in unexpended funds. The contractor has repeatedly expressed an eagerness to continue the work and complete the task, but no further action has been taken. It is requested that OC-EP analyze and evaluate the present and potential requirements for a CS-15 type equipment to determine the desirability of continuing or discontinuing the present project.
