1. On 9 July 1958, the undersigned visited the [Redacted] for the purpose of discussing the CS-15 [Redacted] Collection System. Participating in the discussions were:

2. The first phase of T.O. 13 is a two-month feasibility study of the CS-15 System. If this study indicates that a successful solution may be derived through more intensive effort, the program will continue with Phase II, the development of a working breadboard model.

3. [Redacted] suggested that the Phase I feasibility study not commence until all available information has been collected on the requirements of the CS-15 system. They are especially concerned about [Redacted] since they feel that the problems of automatic analysis, compression, and storage of the [Redacted] will constitute a major factor in determining the feasibility of the proposed system. The government project engineer agreed that the temporary delay of the Phase I study would be to the best interests of the project. Such available information as the contractor requests will be collected by the undersigned and forwarded to [Redacted] at the earliest possible opportunity.
