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(S) In General O'Connell's absence, I have given consideration to your proposal of 16 January 1959 for a joint program to develop a photogalvanic battery [Redacted]

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(S) As a result of technical discussions between representatives of [Redacted] and USASRD, the photogalvanic battery has been included in our FY-60 planned R&D program. Should you decide to negotiate a contract for development of this battery prior to FY-60, I can arrange for the assignment of a project engineer at USASRD to assist in the technical administration of the contract. As soon as our FY-60 budget is finalized, determination will be made as to our ability to participate in the funding of this development.
