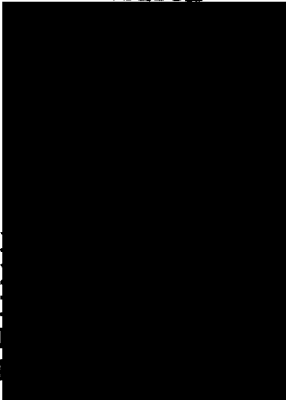

1. Regulations: Mr. Garrison mentioned that a meeting had been held on the writing of regulations and that a committee to write Logistics regulations had been set up. This committee is composed of one member from each Division and/or Staff with [redacted] in charge. However, Mr. Garrison emphasized that the committee in no way relieved the Division and/or Staff Chief from responsibility regarding regulations.

2. Security Violations: The seriousness of security violations was again mentioned and the need of taking precautions against having violations was stressed. [redacted] reported that a possible violation had occurred since his report but that it has not been determined as yet if it is a violation.

Regulation [redacted] announced that proposed Regulation [redacted] concerning procedures for the formulation of Tables of Organization had been withdrawn by subsequent memorandum because of current policy studies which would necessitate significant revisions. [redacted] pointed out that the Regulation was of basic significance to the Agency's organization and should receive careful consideration if and when resubmitted.
