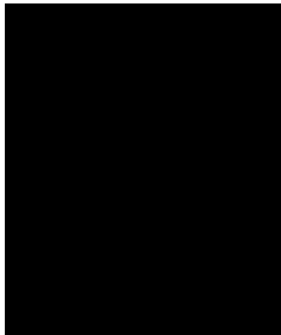

1. Regulations: A progress report of regulations, agency-wide, has been written. Some of the statistics contained in this report are: Of the 340 regulations which were expected to be published in the first year, after eleven months, 68 have been published. This represents only 20% of the total. Of the 20%, an average of 7% was returned for rewrite (LO had 15% returned). At the present time 14% are in [redacted] office for final check prior to publication (33 1/3% of the IO submitted regulations are in [redacted] office).

After reading the above statistics, Mr. Garrison called attention to the importance of staying with the regulations through [redacted] office to final publication and distribution. Submitting regulations to [redacted] is not the last responsibility IO has in writing regulations for publication.
