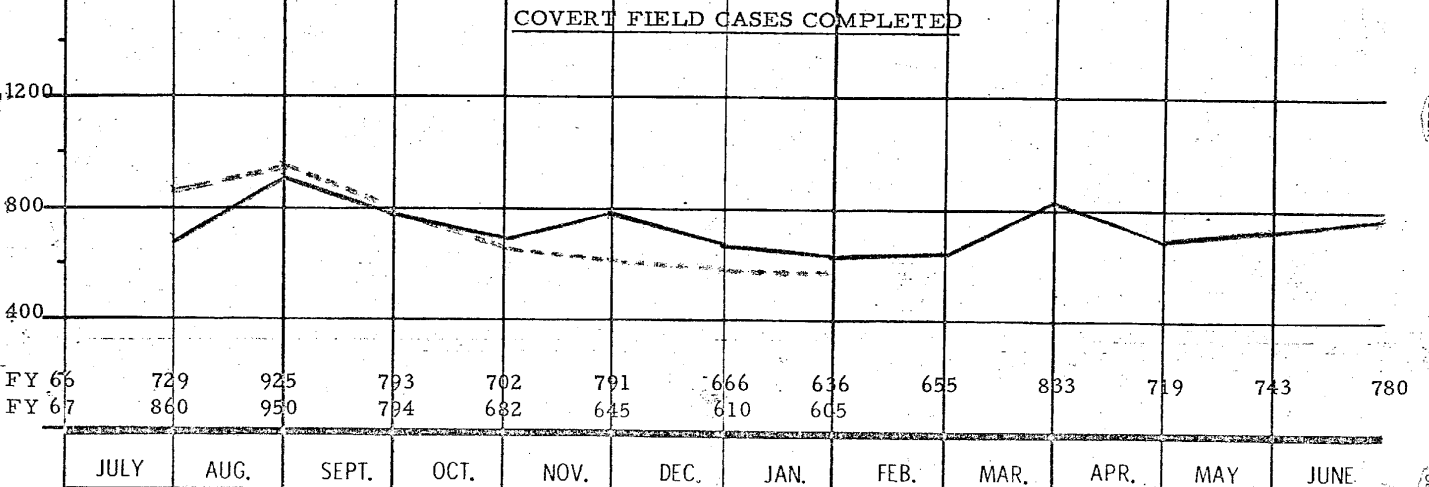
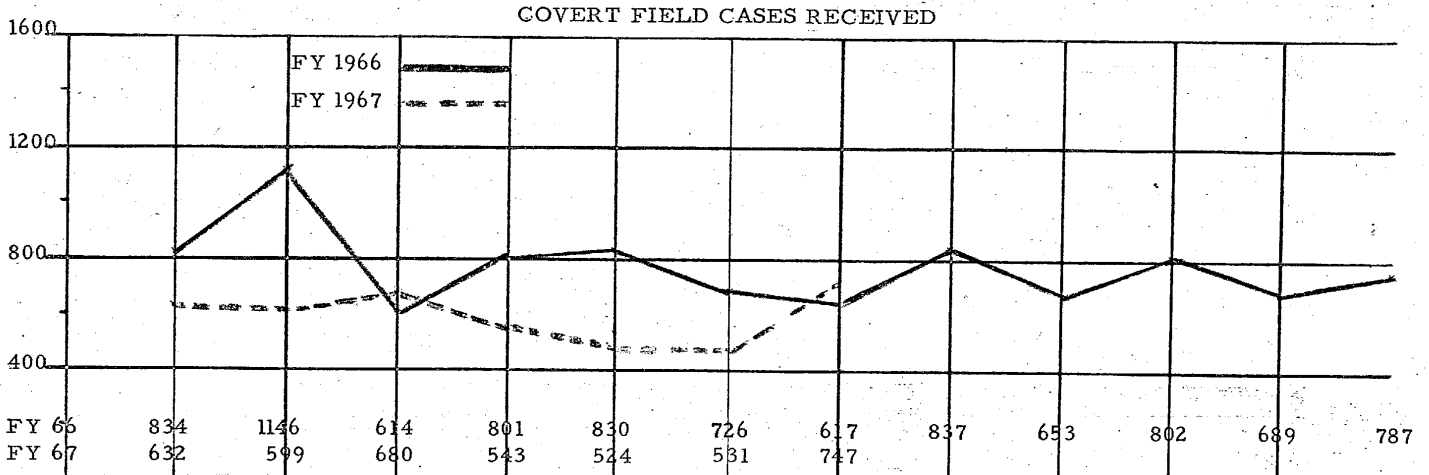
OVERT FIELD CASES RECEIVED

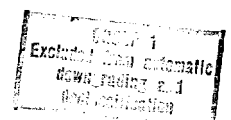
