1. When the CTG Security Office was moved to the South Building, 25X1A9a 2430 "E" Street, a card file was being maintained by purpose of keeping an accurate check on the status of cases being handled by the Security Division for investigation and security clearance. 25X1A9a when advised of this procedure, stated that they deemed the keeping of such a record unnecessary and a duplication of effort. They further stated that adequate records were being maintained by the Records Section. This card file being maintained by was continued, 25X1A9a however, due to the fact that the Chief, Security Division, on the basis of brief checks, determined that accurate records were not being kept by the and therefore it was necessary that this card file be continued.

- 2. On or about 23 December 1946, a voucher was received from the FBI billing the CIG for the amount of \$17,800 for investigations performed on 178 applicants for positions in CIG. This, woucher with attached list of names was turned over to the Records Section to check as quickly as possible. It took the Records Section approximately 25 hours to make this check.
- 3. On 3 January 1917 the Records Section was directed to submit certain information on investigations being handled by the Security Division. A 26 hour period elapsed before this report was made and its accuracy was doubted.
- . was directed 25X1A9a to make a report to the Chief, Security Division, as to the number of cases pending investigation with the FBI for more than six weeks, the report to be made as of 1700 hours 8 January 1947, and to reach the Chief, Security Division, not later than 1100 hours 9 January 1947. This report was not received until 10 January 1947 and it was noted at first glance that it was in was directed to make the necessary corrections on cases 25X1A9a error. shown as pending since before 20 November 1946. The corrected report showed that only lh cases were pending when the original report showed 38 cases as pending with the FBI. Therefore, the report was incorrect on 24 out of 38 25X1A9a cases. stated that corrections were made by the use of the card file maintained by 25X1A9a

4. On Friday morning, 10 January 1947, 25X1A9a came to me and 25X1A9a had directed that no cases be handled or names recorded on 30 personnel except by SO personnel of the Security Division, and therefore, we must discontinue the card file maintained by 25X1A9a (Secretary to the Chief, Security Division) on all personnel being recruited for SO.
