The elimination of the forcest of logistical requirements will necessitate the integration of logistical planning with phases of the Claudestine Sandartine PLANNING the Clandestine Services Planethe System, as stated in reference (a). This will make information available to the Planning Staff, Office of Logistics, by DD/P personnel to permit concurrent logistical planning. It must be emphasized that such information has not been made available to this Office by ED/P in the past. However, if requirement forecasts are to be discarded, ID/P staff personnel must fully realize their responsibility to the logistical planners if successful support to operational activities is to be accomplished under the system. 3. It is recommended that the reduction and eventual elimination
