SUBJECT : Meeting at DIA - 11 May 1966

1. This meeting was called at the request of [redacted] AQ-3, to discuss problems that had arisen in the dissemination of DIA photographs taken during the recent Moscow May Day Parade. 25X1

2. In the absence of [redacted] explained the purpose of the meeting - that [redacted] was concerned with the fact that NPIC had by-passed DIA in their request to FTD for various coverage of the May Day Parade, and that this had led to disruption of established procedures and to costly reproduction of surplus photography. 25X1 25X1

3. We informed DIA that we had learned that the basis of the NPIC request was an agreement between the Director, NPIC, and the Commanding Officer, FTD, that a single Community measurement should be reported on new items of military equipment, and that the direct dissemination of parade photos to NPIC was intended to facilitate the production of joint FTD/NPIC measurements.

4. The DIAAQ position was that they were the established dissemination point and that they did not know of these arrangements. The DIA representatives further requested that Graphics Register coordinate all future NPIC and CIA requirements so that a single consolidated request is levied for parade photography.

5. We agreed to discuss the May Day 1966 problem with NPIC and to provide DIAAQ with a consolidated request well in advance of the next parade in November. The request will spell out both NPIC and Graphics Register's needs for prints, negatives, color transparencies, etc.

the dissemination of the photography to primary users. DIA would
like to have Graphics Register and NPIC levy a single coordinated
