In response to a crash request the Photo Section's "Crash Lab" produced 1,150 photographs of personalities for Vice President Humphrey's trip to Africa, and 465 personality photographs for President Johnson's trip.

In response to a request from the DDP the Section obtained 125 photographs of US Space Vehicle tracking stations in Africa.

As part of the CRS reorganization 30 cabinets of photographs were transferred from the Section to the newly activated ISG/NE/AF Division.
