SUBJECT : Marriage to Aliens

1. Marriage of CIA Employees to Aliens," has been approved and authenticated for publication. It requires, as you know, employees to obtain permission from the DCI prior to marriage with an alien and stipulates that failure to obtain permission prior to marriage shall constitute grounds for dismissal.

2. The DDCI has indicated that he believes the fundamental security questions are identical in the case of applicants for CIA employment who are married to aliens. He requests therefore that appropriate Agency regulations and clearance procedures be revised to reflect comparable consideration of such cases. The existent regulation, which you are probably already revising, is "Policy Clearance of Personnel for Duty with CIA."

- 3. Specifically the Director has indicated that he personally desires to approve the clearance of any prospective employee who is married to an alien.
- 4. Will you, therefore, review the pertinent Agency security regulations and clearance procedures to ensure that the above requirement is carried out in practice and is reflected in the appropriate regulations as quickly as possible.
