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1. At your early convenience I would like to discuss with you the attached audit report on Project MKULTRA (reference a.) and the principles involved therein.

2. In paragraph 13. particularly, I wonder if "it is impermissible to place in the record any details." I also wonder if oral explanations are adequate in the case of Item (2) amounting to \$1,401.23.

3. The thing that concerns me is whether an auditor should report on the conditions of an account as he finds them or accept oral explanations. What will take the place of these oral explanations in the event of a further audit or investigation by someone other than the individual who made the original audit?

4. These are principles which I would like to chat with you about.
