Our representative of the NSC Special Committee on Technical Surveillance Countermeasures, [redacted] has been designated Chairman of a Subcommittee to develop implementation procedures for action on one of the items covered in the Special Committee's "Six Months Report" to the National Security Council. This item pertains to:

25X1A

"Intelligence collection requirements on opposition devices, search techniques, and electronic capabilities related to the development of technical surveillance devices and countermeasures."

The Subcommittee is about ready to submit its report to the full Committee and has concluded that CIA should be assigned the responsibility of devising and levying collection requirements to accomplish the desired objectives on the item referred to above.

It seems to me we are a little premature in drafting all of the implementing papers before the Subcommittee recommendations are accepted by the Special Committee. However, the real purpose in submitting this at this time is to insure that the Agency will subscribe to what the Chairman of the Subcommittee, a CIA man, is about to recommend. I think it should and recommend your approval.
