## THE AMERICAN-KOREAN FOUNDATION CAMPAIGN

1. The emergency campaign of the American-Korean Foundation will be conducted in this Agency from 16 July through 30 July 1954. It is not anticipated that future fund drives will be made by the Foundation.

2. The American-Korean Foundation is a voluntary agency organized so that Americans can help Koreans to meet both their immediate and long-range needs. The objectives of the Foundation are to ease the sufferings of the Korean people and to help them demonstrate the democratic way of life in Asia.

3. Korea needs material aid now such as food; medical supplies and hospital equipment; training for doctors, nurses, and teachers; and facilities for the sick, the disabled, and the destitute. This help must come if Korea is to produce for herself the goods and services which she so desperately needs. In this connection, President Eisenhower has stated:

The plight of the civilian population in Korea is desperate. I have seen with my own eyes the devastation caused by war. Aid to Korea is urgent.

Relief dollars in Korea will literally perform miracles. Fifty cents a day will supply medication to check tuberculosis and about \$10 will buy an artificial limb for an amputee.

I deeply hope that the people of this country will respond generously to the appeal for funds by the American-Korean Foundation.

4. Since this drive is a nonrecurring emergency campaign to help Koreans to help themselves, it is hoped that many employees will contribute to this humanitarian cause.

5. Special contributor envelopes and campaign leaflets will be distributed throughout the Agency by Administrative Officers. These envelopes
