1. You had asked Management Staff to check out the recommendations of the Inspector General that the Proprietary Accounts Branch should receive an increase in T/O.

2. The attached reply from the Chief, Management Staff concludes after studying the situation that a total staff of six (6) people should be adequate to perform the properly assigned functions of this Branch. He further recommends that a comprehensive study be made of the functions of the Area Division, DD/P, Commercial Division, PAPS, and the Proprietary Accounts Branch as they pertain to the planning, implementation and operation of the proprietary projects. He does not indicate who he feels should properly head such a study; however, I wonder if Mr. [REDACTED] would be in a position to coordinate this type of thing.
