SUBJECT: Proposed Revision of Notice [redacted] Career Development of Junior Personnel

1. At Colonel White's suggestion, I discussed with Messrs. Reynolds, AD/P, and Baird, C/TR, the suggestion in [redacted] memorandum of 7 January 1955 (copy attached) regarding the assignment of a trainee when he has concluded his specialized development.

2. Mr. Reynolds was entirely agreeable to making the change but Mr. Baird disagreed vehemently. It was his view that the AD/P would sooner or later have to have the authority to place any employee anywhere in the Agency in that position for which he has shown ability and in which his services are most needed. Mr. Baird pointed out that this is not being done at present and the whole problem of reassignment must be looked upon from the overall Agency point of view.

3. I presented these views to Colonel White and after discussion with Mr. [redacted] and myself, he signed the notice as originally presented, noting that the JCD Program will probably require reviewing anyhow in the near future if it doesn't get off the ground any more than it has so far.
