1. Referenced memorandum has been reviewed, and the following comments concerning it are submitted for your information:

a. With respect to the reassignment of Mr. [redacted] from OTR to replace Mr. [redacted] as the OL Training Officer, the following chain of events occurred:

(1) Memo from Director of Logistics to the Director of Training, dated 5 December 1956, advised that Mr. [redacted] in adherence with plans made by OTR was due to rotate from OL to OTR; and requested that OTR provide a replacement for Mr. [redacted]

(2) During mid-December 1956, OTR Personnel Officer advised the OL Personnel Officer that OTR was nominating Mr. [redacted] as the replacement for Mr. [redacted]

(3) On or about 8 January 1957, determination was made by OL that Mr. [redacted] would be acceptable as the replacement for Mr. [redacted] and OTR advised of this decision. In addition, OTR was requested to make Mr. [redacted] available for entering-on-duty in OL in order that he have an opportunity to work with Mr. [redacted] for an appropriate overlap period.

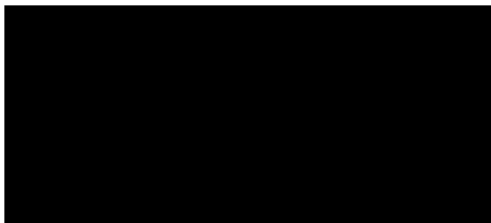
