SUBJECT

Readquarters Overtime

he Comptroller, is steadily improving. We can take special pride in the fact that our "per employee" average has dropped during a partiod in which we cut back our Headquarters T/O strength some 30 positions, a manyour factor normally calculated to increase overtime. Additionally, this new "lov" was achieved during our peak vacation period, July through September, which normally would shift a greater share of the workload to the overtime column.

2. I am not unmindful of the fact that this excellent record is due in large measure to a considerable amount of uncompensated overtime on the part of yourselves and your personnel, and I am sincerely appreciative of the esprit it typifies. I hope that 1958 will continue to reflect the same high stendards we have set for ourselves in this aspect of our management responsibilities. A careful review of authorisations to perform overtime is a matter of paramount importance due to fund limitations.
