MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director (Support)

SUBJECT: Age Limitation For New Employees

REFERENCE: Your memorandum dated 21 February 1957 (DD/S 57-604), same subject

1. This memorandum is for your information concerning our progress in providing for special review of the proposed employment of individuals who might not qualify for full retirement at age 62.

2. Instructions have been issued within the Office of Personnel to refer for consideration in my immediate Office any application from an individual who, taking into account previous and potential creditable service, would not be eligible for retirement at age 62 with a full annuity. Such cases will be reviewed personally by the Director of Personnel or his Deputy to determine, in consultation with the appropriate operating officials, whether further consideration should be given to the application.

3. It is believed that operation under this plan for a period of a few months will give us an experience record on which to base further discussion with you on this subject. At that time, it is suggested that discussion of the subject with the Career Council be further considered.
