Pursuant to our authority to study the Government Employees' Security Program, contained in Senate Resolution 20, agreed to February 21, 1955, and extended, we desire the following information relative to the period July 1, 1955 through March 31, 1956:

Resignations before Determination was Completed
(a) After charges were preferred, or after being advised that charges were to be preferred.

Relative to the persons listed above we should like to have:

1. Date of employment, i.e., date entering employment in your Agency and date leaving employment in your Agency.
2. Number reemployed by your Agency.
3. If person was reemployed by other Federal Agency.
