SUBJECT : Proposed ██████████ "Foreign Residence Restrictions"

John:

1. I wish you would look into the handling of this proposed regulation and give me a report on the excessive amount of time spent on it.

2. In late spring or early summer of 1955, the Director requested that appropriate measures be taken to restrict employees leaving the Agency from remaining in the foreign area to which assigned, when their continued presence would be prejudicial to Agency interests. As a result of this request, a staff study recommending the adoption of certain controls, including a proposed Agreement to be signed by employees going overseas, was submitted to the Director and approved on 23 August 1955.

3. On 3 January 1957 (sixteen months later) this matter was referred to the Office of Personnel by the Regulations Control Staff with the information that all coordinating offices except the Office of the Deputy Director (Plans) had concurred. Recently it was referred to this Office for resolution.

4. I plan to discuss this with the Director and present to him DD/P's position as set forth in Charlie Hulick's memorandum dated 20 December 1956 to the Chief, Regulations Control Staff. However, before doing this, I would like to know why almost a year and a half has been spent on this case and what caused all the delays. I am sure you will agree that this puts us in a very bad light.

If we have any more like this blurring around, please advise me.
