MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

SUBJECT : Funds for Junior Officer Trainee Program

1. This memorandum contains a recommendation submitted for DCI approval. Such recommendation is contained in paragraph 5.

2. The Office of Training has requested an increase in their allocation of funds for Fiscal Year 1958 to meet requirements of the JOT Program. This program was given an approved ceiling of [redacted] positions by the DD/S in connection with the FY 1958 budget and funds were provided for only the [redacted] positions. At that time, however, the Office of Training was instructed to continue recruitment and also to study the problem of reducing the time individual JOT's spent in the program and to reduce, insofar as possible, the period during which individual JOT's were on the JOT allotment. The efforts along these lines have not resulted in a sufficient reduction of time in the program for individual trainees to cover the recruitment and complete the training programmed within funds available in the budget.
