MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Security, Safety, and Emergency Planning - [redacted] 25X1A6a

PRESENT: Colonel White, [redacted] 25X1A9a

TIME : 2 p.m., 11 March 1953

PLACE : Colonel White's Office, 226 Administration Building

1. It was reported to Colonel White that a meeting held on 10 March (see Memorandum for the Record attached) had cleared the majority of the items of the two reports. In reviewing the 10 March Memorandum for the Record, the following action was taken:

- a. [redacted] will study and make a report in support of the recommendation for a horse patrol of [redacted] 25X1A9a 25X1A6a
- b. [redacted] will investigate the possibility of preparation of badges by Inspection and Security here at Headquarters in lieu of purchase of equipment for [redacted] 25X1A9a 25X1A6a
- 25X1A9a c. [redacted] was directed in coordination with [redacted] of Security to prepare a recommendation for study and survey of ways and means of solving the water problem at [redacted]. 25X1A9a 25X1A6a
- d. [redacted] was authorized to go ahead with the installation of the fan in the operating room. 25X1A9a
- e. [redacted] was directed to construct wooden fire escapes for Building 13. 25X1A9a
- f. He was authorized to design and construct an incinerator at a cost not to exceed \$800.
- g. Purchase of the rubber floor pad for the emergency generator house was authorized at approximately \$88.
- h. Purchase of four back packs for fighting brush fires was authorized at approximately \$33 each.

2. The general state of emergency planning [redacted] was discussed briefly. It was agreed that the major items of concern must await solution until the substantive planning recently proposed has been completed. [redacted] was 25X1A6a 25X1A9a

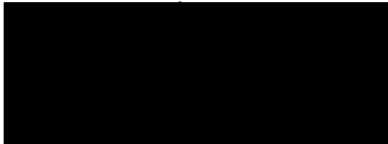
