The flashlights listed became unserviceable because of being bent beyond repair and inoperative switches.

The clothing items and flags were worn out through fair wear and tear.

The kerosene lantern was broken when hit by a truck backing up. The truck driver was not held responsible because of muddy conditions at the construction site.

My findings were the same as is reported by the Responsible Officer in his section of this Survey Report.

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All items listed, except two silver badges which were lost, were turned into Mr. [redacted] for salvage. These items are on hand, except for two flags that have been disposed of by burning, in accordance with existing regulations. I have personally inspected these items now in the warehouse and found them worn out through fair wear and tear or broken in normal operation through no fault of anyone concerned.

The silver badges were determined lost when the inventory showed two short of the supposedly received number. It could be that this number is in error by two badges, since some of the old records are questionable.

I recommend that the Responsible Officer be relieved of all liability in connection with this property survey.
